CHATTERBEE is a mobile app that makes staying connected with friends and family around the world simple, by eliminating the headache of working around different time zones and busy schedules.

"I wish I could talk to my friends and family more often but our schedules never align."

> "I used to talk to my mom every day until I moved. Now we phone-tag each other for at least a week before we can have a conversation."

PROBLEM STATEMENT

User testing has shown that people are having a difficult time keeping in contact with friends and family across time zones. Due to their busy schedules and time differences those interviewed showed a positive correlation between their time differences, busy schedules and losing touch with people they care about. The most common reason given was that busy schedules and time differences make it very difficult to be able to call someone at the right time for a conversation. This has shown to cause the subjects to drift apart.

KEY FINDINGS

The majority of people know someone in a different time zone .

When talking with close friends and family people prefer meaningful face to face conversations as opposed to text messaging.

People prefer to talk on the phone, not on a computer.

Most people use text or social media to figure out what time works for both parties for to talk. This usually takes a while and is not convenient.


NEEDS AND WANTS

Shared points of frustration

People are frustrated by the amount of time and effort it takes to plan a call with their close friends and family. This creates the desire for a simple solution that doesn't require tireless effort.


During my research I found out that people prefer video chat to audio chat. There also seems to be a lot of interest around camera filters, stickers and screen doodles.







USER TESTING

Discovery

Users were mostly confused about request vs. scheduling features. They assumed that the two were the same thing and didn't know to go to the Requests tab to check on the status of unscheduled calls. Users were also confused about the calendar feature under the Scheduling tab. This was mostly due to the location of the calendar.









WHAT I LEARNED


